

To receive a Waterford High School Varsity Letter, students must complete one season of satisfactory high school membership and be a WWST member in good standing during their shooting tenure. Numerals will be awarded for first year high school JV shooters in good standing. Earning Numerals or a Varsity Letter in competitive shooting will be based on a point system. The opportunity to earn points will be from February through May. A student-athlete must accumulate a total of 100 points to earn a Varsity Letter or Numerals. Points cannot transfer from one season to the next. The point schedule shall be as follows:

Participation in WWST Activities:

Practice attendance: 3 points each

Competition attendance: 5 points each

Averages and Awards:

Averages are calculated from competition scores (trap, skeet and sporting clays) only and do not include practice scores. An athlete must accumulate a minimum of six (6) practice scores for their average to count.

Average 85—100% 30 points

Average 70—84.9% 20 points

Average below 70% 0 points

Place 1st as a squad or individual in any competition 3 points

Place 2nd as a squad or individual in any competition 2 points

Place 3rd as a squad or individual in any competition 1 point

Program Involvement:

Help for one hour at practice with pulling / scoring 3 points

Clean team guns for 30 minutes before or after practice 5 points

Attend WWST Youth Board meetings 5 points per meeting

The Head Coach reserves the right to award extra points based on individual performance, on and off the line.
